

Virtual Visit Data Guidance

Purpose

This document provides guidance on the purposes of organization & provincial reporting, clinical documentation and audit. It supports the Virtual Visit Solutions Standards developed by Ontario Health (OTN) and provides details in supporting future interoperability requirements. This document is a draft document and there are no warranties and the contents are subject to change.

Audience

The audience is intended for solution providers, system administrators who have the accountability of ensuring solutions meet the data requirements outlined in the Virtual Visit Solutions Standard v1.1.

Digital Health Information Exchange Policy

Data requirements may be revised to respond to changes to PHIPA Reg 329/04 and the Digital Health Information Exchange Policy.

General

1. Each record should represent a single virtual visit event, which is a unique interaction between a provider/consultant or Most Responsible Person (MRP) and a patient.
2. Each event must be uniquely identified by its Event ID.
3. If an event involves more than one patient, even with the same provider, each event should have its own unique Event ID.

This document speaks to the mandatory and recommended data fields. The mandatory fields are in scope for data reporting and audit purposes, while the recommended data fields are intended for future interoperability and clinical documentation purposes.

Solution providers are expected to maintain an audit log that complies with the mandatory requirements in the virtual care solution standard.

Ontario recommends that health information data exchange follows the HL7 FHIR standards. Further work is necessary to develop standard HL7 FHIR profiles and structure data using health/clinical terminology standards such as SNOMED CT and LOINC where possible, for this area of focus for Canadian jurisdictions to advance interoperability.
